



Pastoral Advisory Committee

The Pastoral Advisory Committee is intended to counsel, encourage, and advise the Board of Directors of Vision Baptist Missions as they carry out their work according to the Bible and the policies and procedures of Vision Baptist Missions.

The Requirements for the Pastoral Advisory Committee:

1. Men who hold to the doctrinal beliefs of Vision Baptist Missions and share the same vision and ministry philosophy as Vision Baptist Missions.
2. Men who are mature in their faith and have at least ten years of experience in pastoral leadership.
3. Men of character, integrity, and wisdom.
4. Men whose churches and personal situations enable them to do this work voluntarily without any financial remuneration.

The Duties of the Pastoral Advisory Committee:

- Once per quarter, the Pastoral Advisory Committee will meet with the Board of Directors either at the VBM home office or another designated location to fulfill work related to this role. More meetings, either in person or online, may be necessary during emergent situations.
- Once a month, the Pastoral Advisory Committee will review updates from the Board of Directors and give counsel and guidance regarding plans and decisions that need to be made.
- The Pastoral Advisory Committee will evaluate and give counsel on any complaint or accusation made about VBM.

Details about the Pastoral Advisory Committee:

- The initial Chairman of the Committee will be Pastor Trent Cornwell of Vision Baptist Church. This position will be voted on each year by members of the Pastoral Advisory Committee.
- Each member of the Pastoral Advisory Committee will be appointed by the Board of Directors and approved by the Pastoral Advisory Committee.
- Members of the Pastoral Advisory Committee will be asked to serve for a minimum of one year. At the end of three years, members will automatically be removed from the Pastoral Advisory Committee unless asked to continue by the Board of Directors. There is no limit to how many three-year terms a pastor may be asked to serve, provided he meets the qualifications and is approved by the Board of Directors.
